Phase I Reporting (Milestone)	 Each Collaborative member will submit a report to DOE at the end of Phase summarizing: All elements from routine reporting, Implementation outcomes (as relevant), How Collaborative members will incorporate feedback from IEDO, Plans for implementation, and Collaborative members will also be asked to provide feedback to IEDO to facilitate continuous improvement of the ISEED program. Reporting templates with required metrics will be provided by IEDO. 	
Routine Member Meetings (Activity only)	 During the project initiation phase, the IEDO will meet with each Collaborative member monthly to discuss: Progress towards goals. Challenges they may be facing. Any resources that could support their work (for example through the workshops or summit described below). Early meetings will focus more on scoping, while later calls will focus more on progress, deliverables, and outcomes. As the projects progress, the frequency of meetings will transition to bimonthly or even quarterly, as determined by the level of guidance required from the committee members. 	
Mid-Year Virtual Collaborative Meeting (half day) (Milestone)	Collaborative members will meet virtually to share and offer peer feedback on progress and challenges in developing and piloting programs/content. Subject matter experts may be brought in depending on needs of members.	

End of Phase 1 Presentations (Full day Virtual Meeting) (Milestone)	Members will present on progress, outcomes, plans, and next steps. Members will receive feedback on the content of their presentations from other Collaborative members, Steering Committee, DOE, and other subject matter experts.
